1. Setting Date and Time Format in Windows 95/98

To set your PC date and time format to the following format:

Time Format : h:mm:ss tt	Date format Time Format	:	dd/MM/yyyy h:mm:ss tt
--------------------------	----------------------------	---	--------------------------

Steps:

- Open the Windows Control Panel Folder by clicking on Start Settings-Control Panel.
- Double click on the **Regional Settings** icon.
- Click on the 'Date' tab and change the short date style to dd/MM/yyyy
- Put the Date Separator as '/ '.
- Click the 'Time' tab and change the time style to h:mm:ss tt
- Click on **OK** button.

2. Setting Date and Time Format in Windows NT/Windows XP

To set your PC date and time format to the following format:

Date format	:	dd/MM/yyyy
Time Format	:	h:mm:ss tt

Steps:

- Open the Windows Control Panel Folder by clicking on Start Settings-Control Panel.
- Double click on the **Regional and Language Options** icon.
- Click on 'Customize' button.
- Click on the 'Date' tab and change the short date style/format to dd/MM/yyyy
- Put the Date Separator as '/ '
