AMENDMENTS TO DIRECTIVE NO. 7.05(1)-001 (DIRECTIVES ON THE USE OF DAY TRADING ACTIVITIES ACCOUNT) AND DIRECTIVE NO. 8-003 (DIRECTIVES ON INTRADAY SHORT SELLING) IN RELATION TO THE EXCEPTIONAL REPORTING TEMPLATES

1.0 AMENDMENTS TO THE EXCEPTIONAL REPORTING TEMPLATES

- 1.1 Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (“**the Exchange**”) is simplifying the Exceptional Reporting templates in Directive No. 7.05(1)-001 (Directives on the Use of Day Trading Activities Account) and Directive No. 8-003 (Directives on Intraday Short Selling) (collectively “**the Directives**”) by amending the heading in the second last column of the Exceptional Reporting templates to state “Reasons” only.
- 1.2 The amendments to the Exceptional Reporting templates are set out in **Annexure 1**.

2.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

- 2.1 The amendments to the Exceptional Reporting templates above will take effect from **16 April 2018** and will supersede the amendments on the Exceptional Reporting templates for Intraday Short Selling in Directive No. 8-003 (Directives on Intraday Short Selling) issued vide the Participating Organisations’ Circular R/R 5 of 2018.
