DIRECTIVE ON THE TRADING PARTICIPANTS' IT SECURITY STANDARDS

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Reference is made to Trading Participant Information Technology Security Code ("TP IT Security Code") issued vide Trading Participant Circular No. 14/2008.
- 1.2 Bursa Malaysia Derivatives Berhad ("**the Exchange**") has updated the TP IT Security Code for compliance with international information security standards, specifically the best practices under the ISO 27001 standard and to reflect a principles-based approach, where appropriate.

2. DIRECTIVE 601.2B-001

- 2.1 In light of the above, the TP IT Security Code has been amended and re-issued as Directive No. 601.2B-001 (Directive on the Trading Participants' IT Security Standards) ("**Directive**").
- 2.2 In relation to the TP IT Security Standards, amendments were made compliance with ISO 27001 as mentioned above, as well as to remove certain prescriptive standards. For ease of reference, the existing ITSS 1 to ITSS 12 can be mapped to the TP IT Security Standards as follows:
